

TOAST OF THE TOWN

This spectacular five-bedroom family house on the Toast Rack with direct access to Wandsworth Common, has the longest garden in the road – as well as off street parking.

The house is in immaculate condition and the 116 foot long garden is full of colour and interest.

The wide entrance hall is filled with light and has a decorative stained glass window to the left. To the right is a wider than average drawing room with a fireplace, alcove storage and plantation shutters on the windows. This room has been opened up to link through to the second reception room, deeper in length and also with an attractive fireplace.

To the rear of the house is a stunning kitchen and family room that provides access to the garden. The kitchen is Bulthaup and the glass extension provides a fantastic view towards the Common.

There is also a large guest cloakroom, a utility room, access to the cellar and a side entrance on the ground floor.


On the first floor the master bedroom suite is located to the back of the house to give far reaching views over Wandsworth Common. There is a generous en-suite with dual vanity units, a large free standing bath and shower.

The landing has been opened up to provide a study area and to the front of the house is the guest bedroom, also with an en suite shower room. Upstairs there are a further three bedrooms. In total there are three bathrooms. There is extra storage in the large loft.

The garden has a comfortable patio with plenty of room for entertaining, with a lawn and mature bedding. A discreet gate provides direct access onto Wandsworth Common.
